- To decorate your patio with blooms for the rest of the winter use geraniums in full sun and primula or cyclamen in the shade. Bluebonnets won't start blooming until mid-March, but they are also showy and reflect a distinctive Texas look.
- There have been traces of rain but not enough to meet the water needs of birds in your landscape. Set-up one or more bird baths and refill them every day. Right now, the flocks of cedar waxwings feeding on ligustrum and pyracantha berries are seeking drinking water.
