- If your winter lawn included grassy weeds such as annual bluegrass and rescue grass it is trying
 to set seed now and will be declining while the permanent lawn grass is greening up for the
 summer. Keep the lawn mowed to reduce the seeding and ignore the yellowing caused by the
 weeds declining.
- Wildflowers need to be allowed to mature their seed if you want the seed produced for next
 year's flowers. It means tolerating a weedy look while the seeds are produced. Don't mow the
 wildflower areas until early summer for maximum seed production.
- Call in your irrigation contractor to perform an inspection and perform necessary maintenance to eliminate leaks and prepare for the irrigation season ahead.
