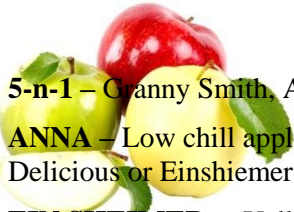




## DECIDUOUS FRUIT TREES 2016

### APPLES



**5-n-1** – Granny Smith, Anna, Mollies Delicious, Fuji, Gala, Einzheimer. Self-pollinating. (200-500 hrs.)

**ANNA** – Low chill apple, fruit is red, ripens in July, self-fertile but will fruit heavier with a pollinator, recommend Golden Delicious or Einzheimer. (200 hrs.)

**EIN SHEIMER** – Yellow, large crisp fruit with a tart flavor. Ripens mid-June to early July. Needs pollinator, recommend Anna or Fuji. (350 hrs.)

**FUJI** – This firm, crunchy, juicy, white fleshed apple has excellent flavor and fine visual appeal. It is of medium size with a lovely reddish-green color. Needs pollinator, recommend Mollies Delicious, Granny Smith (350-400 hrs.)

**GRANNY SMITH** – Bright green color; tart, firm, juicy apple. Good for juice, eating, and cooking; excellent storage. Strong and vigorous tree; thrives in hot climate. Needs pollinating, recommend Gala. Ripens August - September. (600-700 hrs.)

**MOLLIES DELICIOUS** – Very large, yellow skin with pink blush. Firm, sweet, juicy, light yellow flesh with pleasant flavor. Ripens in late July. Needs pollinator, recommend Fuji or Granny Smith. (400-500 hrs.)

### NECTARINES



**SUNGLO** - The red-skinned nectarines are yellow fleshed and free-stone. Ripens in August. (650 hrs.)

**\*SMOOTH TEXAN ONE** – Tangy-sweet, yellow flesh nectarine. Yields in mid-May. (550 hrs.)

**\*SMOOTH TEXAN TWO** – Tangy-sweet nectarine. Yields late May. (550 hrs.)

**\*SMOOTH TEXAN THREE** – A low acid, yellow flesh nectarine. Yields in early June. (600 hrs.)

**\*SMOOTH ZEST ONE** – A tangy-sweet, white flesh nectarine. Yields in early to mid-May. (250 hrs.)

### PLUMS

**BRUCE** – Large. Red skin, red flesh, delicious flavor. Needs pollinator, recommend Santa Rosa or Methley. (500 hrs.)

**METHLEY** – Reddish purple color plum with amber red flesh; large, juicy, sweet fruit. Excellent for eating, jellies and preserves. Vigorous grower and heavy bearer; self-fertile but fruits better with pollinator; ripens June-July. (250 hrs.)

**SANTA ROSA** – Purplish red fruit with amber yellow flesh; large, sweet, tangy, firm, oval plum; compact prolific growing tree; excellent for eating, jellies and preserves; self-pollinating; ripens June - July. (400 hrs.)



### PEARS

**KIEFFER** – Large hard pear, excellent for canning and cooking. Ripens September. Self-pollinating. (350 hrs.)

**MOONGLOW** – Excellent large pear with soft juicy flesh. Ripens late August, early September. Self-pollinating but will fruit heavier with cross pollinator. (700 hrs.)

**ORIENT** – Yellow russet sweet, juicy pear; creamy white flesh with firm, smooth texture; good for mild winter areas; use KIEFFER or MOONGLOW as pollinator; ripens August. Self-pollinating but will fruit heavier with a cross pollinator, recommend Kieffer or Moonglow (400 hrs.)



# PEACHES

**3-N-1** – June Gold, Tex Star, Florida King. (300-650 hrs.)

**BELLE OF GEORGIA** – Rosy freestone peaches. Super sweet, juicy white flesh. Ripens in August. (650 hrs.)

**\*FLAT DELIGHT ONE** – A white flesh, low acid, donut-shaped peach. Harvest mid-May (550 hrs.)

**FLORIDA KING** – Large, firm, attractive, yellow-fleshed clingstone fruit. Ripens in May. (450 hrs.)

**\*GOLDEN ZEST** – Firm, yellow fleshed peached. Traditional acidity. Harvest late June. (600 hrs.)

**JUNE GOLD** - Large, firm, and slightly red, with a yellow flesh and are a clingstone peach. Ripens early June. (650 hrs.)

**LA FELICIANA** – Large, yellow flesh freestone; self-fertile; ripens mid-June - July. (550-600 hrs.)

**REDSKIN** - A large, well colored freestone with yellow flesh. Ripens July. (750 hrs)

**RED BARON** – About 3” in diameter. Yellow flesh, freestone, sweet, juicy flavor. Ripens from mid-July to mid-August. (250 hrs.)

**RIO GRANDE** – Mature to 15-25’ and 15’ wide. Tolerates heat and humidity well. Freestone peach with red blush on yellow skin. Productive with showy flowers and most adaptable of all fruit trees. Makes a wonderful addition to your backyard orchard. (425 hrs.)

**\*ROYAL ZEST ONE** – Firm, yellow fleshed peaches. Harvest mid-May. (600 hrs.)

**\*ROYAL ZEST TWO** – Firm, yellow fleshed peaches. Harvest early June. (500 hrs.)

**\*ROYAL ZEST THREE** – Yellow flesh, semi-freestone, tangy-sweet peach. Harvest mid-June. (550 hrs.)

**\*ROYAL ZEST FOUR** – Firm, yellow fleshed peaches. Harvest mid to late June. (600 hrs.)

**SAM HOUSTON** – Sweet, yellow flesh and is a large, self-fertile and freestone peach with a small pit. 12-15’ tall with a 12-15’ width (500 hrs.)

**SENTINEL** - Large, semi-freestone fruits of excellent quality. Self-fertile. (850 hrs)

**\*TEX PRINCE** – A tangy-sweet, yellow flesh, freestone peach. Harvest late May. (550 hrs.)

**TEXSTAR** – Medium fruit, Semi –clingstone, ripens late spring. Good for canning, baking and eating fresh. (450hrs)

**\* WHITE DELIGHT (II)** – White flesh, low acid, semi-free, ripens early to mid-June (550 hrs.)

**\*WHITE ZEST ONE** – A semi- freestone, tangy-sweet peach. Harvest mid-June. (550 hrs.)

**\* Denotes new Texas A&M Varieties.**

**FREESTONE:** Fruit of the peach separates easily from the pit. Used for eating fresh or freezing.

**CLINGSTONE:** Fruit of the peach clings tightly to the pit. Used for canning.

# JUJUBE

Round, reddish-brown fruit 1 ½ inches long. Sweet and chewy like a date. Easy to grow and maintain. Very cold hardy and drought resistant. Pest and disease free. Thrives in climates with long hot summers. Self-fruitful. (150 hrs.)

# GINGER

**ZINGIBER “BABY GINGER”** – Great selection of yellow edible ginger, tender with mild flavor. Does not need to be peeled.

**A CHILL HOUR IS ONE HOUR AT OR BELOW 45 DEGREES**
