

ARBEQUINA

A tree of small stature typically 15 feet in height at maturity. Earliest to bear fruit, usually by three years of age. We have found Arbequina to be not only among the most cold tolerant olive trees but also the most adaptable to a variety of growing conditions. Self-fertile. Used for oil or table fruit. Excellent dried fruit or pickled at any stage.

ARBOSANA

Tree is small in stature with high yields. The yield in oil is very good (19- 20%). Oil has a unique fruity flavor. Late maturing with high producing fruit with a tendency toward alternate bearing. Resistant to leaf drop and cold. Selffertile.
