



PECAN TREES 2016

CADDO

Regular producer with good yields, scab resistant.

CHEYENNE

Nuts are medium size, 55 to 60 to a pound. Bears heavy and early. Does well in most regions.

FORKERT

Produces very large, thin-shelled pecans of excellent quality. Perfect tree for home growing. 47 nuts per pound.

DESIRABLE

Large nut bears consistent average crop once in production, good scab resistance, good yard tree.

KANZA

Compact, easily shelled nuts with outstanding flavor. Excellent shade tree with good cold tolerance and disease resistance. Pollinate with 'Pawnee'.

ADVANTAGES OF CONTAINER GROWN PECAN TREES

- 1) Container trees can be planted any time. Bare root trees may be planted during dormant season only.
- 2) A big advantage to buying container trees is that the tops do not need to be pruned. Therefore, no shock or setback and a higher survival rate.
- 3) Container trees will grow much more the first year compared to bare root or packaged trees.
