



Avocado Trees 2017

BRAZOS BELLE

Medium to large black-purple fruit. This is a very cold hardy variety of avocado (withstanding temperatures as low as 14° F) that has the typical flavor of a Mexican Avocado. Fruit ripens from August-September. This tree ranges 10'-15' in height.

JOEY

Founded by Joey Ricers in Uvalde, Texas. The egg shaped fruit is medium in size. It has excellent flavor. The skin is purple-black in color. Heavy producer and cold hardy to 17° F. Ripens August-September.

LILA

Medium sized, pear shaped, green fruit. Lila has a rich Mexican Avocado flavor. The fruit ripens from August-September. Lila is very cold hardy down to 14° F. This tree ranges from 10'-15' in height.

MEXICOLA

High quality small fruit with thin shiny black skin. Cold hardy down to 20° F. Ripens August-October.

MEXICOLA GRANDE

This high quality fruit is indeed a true avocado variety. It has a glossy, nearly black, thin skin and rich, nutty flesh. Fruit size can range from four ounces to eight ounces. Ripens in September. Hardy to about 18° F.

PANCHO

A medium-large, light green fruit, cold hardy Mexican avocado. An old variety with very thin skin. Cold hardy to 20° F. Ripens August-September.

DON JUAN

Mexican Avocado, very cold hardy to 14° F. Tall and spreading growth habit.

Trees are hardy to temperatures indicated when fully mature and may need protection for up to 3 years.
